## **“Curating Contemporary Art” Seminar Programme List of Conditions**

Application conditions and detailed information of “Curating Contemporary Art” themed seminar programme organized by Open Dialogue Istanbul and Akbank Sanat in collaboration are stated below.

### **Programme Fact Sheet:**

- Study period: November 2019 – May 2020 / 7 Months / 25 Weeks / 50 lessons / 175 hours of training and final project.
- Programme will be held with minimum 6 and maximum 20 participant attendance (The number of participants attending the entire programme).
- Training Spaces: Open Dialogue Istanbul and Akbank Sanat
- The seminars in Open Dialogue Istanbul will be held every **Friday between 18:00-21:30**, the seminars in Akbank Sanat will be held every **Saturday between 16:00-19:30**.
- This programme is expected to be completed in a period of 7 months including internship, study visits and the completion of the final project.
- A certificate of completion will be given to participants attending the entire programme.

### **Application Conditions:**

- The candidates should be university graduates or post-graduates with majors in the fields such as sociology, philosophy, art management, political science, history of art, visual arts, architecture...
- Application fee for the programme is can be paid in full or in installments; please see the details below for further information:
  - 1) Fee for full attendancy to the programme is 3.750 TL. + vat per person.
  - 2) For participants who prefer to attend some of the seminars only could pay on a daily basis. In this case each seminar (based on 3,5 hours) would cost 100 TL.
- Participants considering to attend the entire programme will be able to pay in two installments.

The first installment (pre-registration perios): 15 October 2019

The second installment: 15 December 2019
